Cadet Orchestra

Scales are to be played quarter note=100mm, detache, with no vibrato, and with the top note repeated.

- Violin G Major (2 octaves, starting on open G)
 - D Major (2 octaves, starting on open D)

A melodic minor (1 octave, starting with 1st finger on the G string)

- Viola C Major (2 octaves, starting on open C)
 - G Major (2 octaves, starting on open G)

A melodic minor (1 octave, starting with 1st finger on the G string)

- Cello C Major (2 octaves, starting on open C)
 - G Major (2 octaves, starting on open G)

A melodic minor (1 octave, starting with 1st finger on the G string)

- Bass G Major (2 octaves, starting with 2nd finger on the E string)
 - D Major (2 octaves; play the 1st note as open D, but drop down to open E on the 2nd note)

A melodic minor (1 octave, starting on open A)

Concert Orchestra

Scales are to be played quarter note=100mm, detache, with no vibrato, and with the top note repeated. All scales for the Concert Orchestra are 2 octave scales.

Violin, Viola, Cello, and Bass* - Major Scales that have up to 3 sharps and 3 flats:

C, G, D, A, F, B flat, and E flat Major (all are 2 octaves)

A and D melodic minor (both are 2 octaves)

*Three of the Bass scales are to be played as "drop-down" scales:

- D Major (2 octaves; play the 1st note as open D, but drop down to open E on the 2nd note)
- E flat Major (2 octaves; play the first note in half position on the D string, but drop down to F on the E string for the 2nd note)
- D melodic minor (2 octaves; play the 1st note as open D, but drop down to open E on the 2nd note)
